CLASS I A: THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY OR WITHIN 3 HOURS BY TELEPHONE TO (847) 377-8130 OR FAX (847) 360-7365:

***If suspected to be a Bioterrorism event or part of an outbreak**

Any unusual case or cluster of which may indicate a public health hazard, including food borne / waterborne, illness (immediately)

CLASS I B: THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE REPORTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BY TELEPHONE BUT WITHIN 24 HOURS

Chicken Pox all ages	Mumps
Cholera	Neisseria Meningitidis, (meningitis / invasive disease)
Diphtheria	Pertussis (whooping cough)
Enteric Escherichia coli infection	Poliomyelitis
Haemophilus Influenzae Invasive	Rabies, Human
Hantavirus	Rabies Potential Human Exposure
Hemolytic Uremic Syndrome, post diarrheal	Rubella
Hepatitis A	Smallpox Vaccine complications
Measles	Streptococcus Group A Invasive
MRSA in infants <61 days and laboratory confirmed clusters (2 or more) in a community setting	Typhoid fever

CLASS II: THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE REPORTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BY TELEPHONE BUT WITHIN 7 DAYS

Arboviral Neurological Infections (Encephalitis / Meningitis)	Leptospirosis
Creutzfeldt-Jakob Disease	Listeriosis
Cryptosporidiosis	Malaria
Cyclosporiasis	Psittacosis
Giardiasis	<i>Salmonellosis</i> (other than typhoid fever)
